Official Guidelines

- **Standing/Status:** Eligible candidates must be deceased, though they need not have died while serving.
- **Branch of Service:** A veteran is an individual who served in Military Departments as defined under Department of Defense Directive 5100.1 which include the Departments of the Army, Navy and Air Force. The Marine Corps is part of the Department of Navy. The Coast Guard operates under the Department of the Navy (on declaration of war or upon Presidential edict). Eligible candidates must also be considered Veterans.
 - Full time National Guard duty is only considered such when National Guard members are activated to regular service and does not include weekend drills or active duty for training Minimum Service Exception (for Death or Disability)
- **Level of Service:** Eligible military candidates must have been honorably discharged.
- **Verification:** Documentary proof of a candidate's service should accompany the Nomination Form. Proof may come in a variety of forms, but should be verifiable without requiring an excessive amount of staff time. The DD Form 214 (Report of Separation) is the town's preferred documentation for military candidates. Before January 1, 1950, several similar forms were used by the military services, including the WD AGO 53, WD AGO 55, WD AGO 53-55, NAVPERS 553, NAVMC 78PD, and the NAVCG 553.
- **Relationship to Randolph, MA:** The eligible military candidate must have resided in Randolph during the candidate's lifetime.
